McSherrystown, Pennsylvania Reorganization Meeting January 6, 2020

Council of the Borough of McSherrystown held its reorganization meeting on Monday, January 6th, 2020 at 6 p.m. in the Municipal Building, 338 Main Street, McSherrystown, Adams County, Pennsylvania with Mayor Anthony J. Weaver presiding.

Mayor Weaver led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America and the Invocation for Divine Guidance.

Prior to the meeting, newly elected Councilmembers Daniel P. Colgan, Joyce E. Murren, Mark A. Lookenbill, William F. Smith were administered the oath of office by the County of Adams. Lisa B. Koontz, who had previously been appointed to complete the term of Council President Patricia D. McKim-Bortner, took her oath of office before Magistrate Daniel S. Bowman. Mayor Anthony J. Weaver administered the oath of office to newly elected Councilmember Joseph E. VonSas.

Present on roll call were Councilmembers Daniel P. Colgan, Lisa B. Koontz, Mark A. Lookenbill, Joyce E. Murren, Stephen J. Pascoe, William F. Smith, and Joseph E. VonSas. Other officials in attendance included Anthony J. Weaver (Mayor,) Scott J. Cook (Manager,) and Gerald C. Walmer (Secretary/Treasurer.) Justin M. George, Esq. was also present.

Mayor Weaver called for <u>nominations from the floor for the office of President</u>. Councilmember Lisa Koontz nominates Joe Vonsas for the office of president. Councilmember Dan Colgan nominates Bill Smith for the office of president.

Councilmember Joe VonSas nominates Steve Pascoe for the office of president. There being no further nominations, a roll call vote was taken.

Mayor Weaver called for <u>nominations from the floor for the office of Vice President</u>. Councilmember Joy Murren nominates Dan Colgan for the office of Vice President. Councilmember Joe VonSas nominates Lisa Koontz for the office of Vice President. There being no further nominations, a roll call vote was taken.

With a majority vote, Dan Colgan is named Borough Council Vice President.

Mayor Weaver handed the gavel over to Council President Bill Smith.

Solicitor Justin George explained the role of Chairman Pro-Tem.

President Smith, noting the need for experience on the Borough Council, appointed Councilmember Joe VonSas as Chairman Pro-Tem in the event there would be an absence of both the President and Vice President at a meeting. The chairman would then preside only if there were a quorum present. Councilmember Joe VonSas formally accepted the appointment.

President Smith noted that there should be a registered elector of the Borough appointed to serve as Chairman of the Vacancy Board. The Chairman would preside over the Board to fill a council vacancy within 30 days should the sitting Council fail to do so. Manager Cook explained that in the past, Gary Green served as Chairman of the Vacancy Board, but had never been called upon to serve in that roll. President Smith asked that he be contacted in regards to filling that vacancy.

President Smith inquired about specific community members who previously sat on the various Borough committees. Manager Cook explained that Councilmembers were typically the only individuals serving on committees other than the Civil Service Committee and the Pension Board. Solicitor George explained that most committee

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assignments are held by Council members. President Smith tabled the naming of committee assignments until the next meeting.

The time and place for regular meetings of Borough Council was set for the second Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. Meetings will be held at the Municipal Building located at 338 Mains Street, McSherrystown. Labor/Management meets upon request.

Councilmember Colgan moves a motion to accept the time and place for regular meetings and was seconded by Councilmember VonSas. Motion carries.

Councilmember Colgan moved a motion to require a roll call for all votes taken by Borough Council. Joy Murren seconded his motion. Motion carries.

<u>Councilmember Vonsas moved a motion to keep ACNB as depository for the Borough's funds. He was seconded by Councilmember Lookenbill.</u>

After a discussion regarding job descriptions associated with Resolution 2020-3, Manager Cook recommended that something similar to a workshop take place so that new members of Council can gain a better understanding of the various roles and responsibilities of Borough employees. President Smith, along with Mayor Weaver thought that Manager Cook's recommendation was needed and should take place.
